Konferencen har 100 deltagere og går under navnet Asian-Europa Classroom Network Conference. Den varer ugen ud.

Princess was handed flowers by little Signe

Princess Marie opened a school and climate conference in Sønderborg on a raw October day.

In keeping with tradition, royal flowers were presented to Princess Marie when she visited Sønderborg today. It was Signe Brodersen from grade 5. b at Hørup Centralskole, who presented the blooms to the Princess.

Marie is used to all kind of weather, including squally wind from her every day life at Schackenborg in Møgeltønder, in the flat wind-swept part of the southwestern Sønderjylland.

With her attire she showed she was prepared for the raw October weather. Marie was clad in a nice warm grey woolen jacket which was tight wrapped around her neck.

Marie made the trip across Sønderjylland from Møgeltønder in the west to Sønderborg in the east to open the conference. This is the eighth conference where school teachers and students from all over Asia and Europe network across borders.

But it was the princess who caused a stir when she occupied the rostrum.

She opened her speech by saying, “It is a great privilege for me to be allowed to take part in opening this conference. The general topic for the conference this year is climate and sustainability, a very relevant topic because of the climate summit meeting in Copenhagen in December. The objective for the coming days is for you to inspire each other in discussions on the climate and sustainability”.

This was the Asia-Europe Classroom Network Conference, where 100 participants networked for a whole week.
